RoHS

The directive 2015/863/EU, of June 4 of 2015, from the European Parliament and Council, detail restrictions of use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment.

The directive regulates what kind of substances can be used in electrical and electronic equipment in the marketplace. RoHS identified substances that will be banned from electrical and electronic products sold in Europe are:

- · Hexavalent Chromium (0.1%)
- · Cadmium (0.01%)
- · Polybrominated biphenyl (PBB) (0.1%)
- · Polybrominated diphenyl ether (PBDE) (0.1%)
- Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) (0.1%) (from 22 July 2019)
 Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP) (0.1%) (from 22 July 2019)
 Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) (0.1%) (from 22 July 2019)
 Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) (0.1%) (from 22 July 2019)
