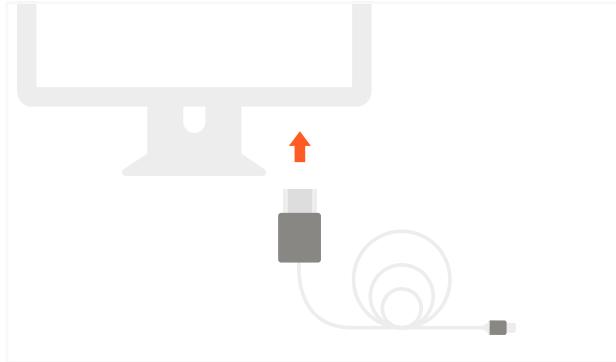


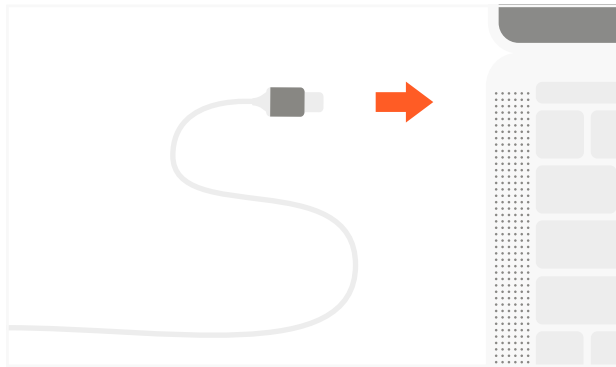
INSTRUCTIONAL GUIDE

TYPE-C TO HDMI CABLE

- 1 Plug Type-C to HDMI cable into HDMI-equipped external monitor.
Backwards compatible with HDMI 1.4 displays and up.



- 2 Connect Type-C to HDMI Cable to your USB-C or Thunderbolt 3 device.
USB-C device must support DisplayPort over USB-C connection.



- 3 The Cable provides stable connection in resolutions up to 3840 x 2160 @ 60Hz.
Resolution and refresh rate depend on the host device and external display capabilities.
